NEW DIVISION FOR CHAMPIONSHIPS EAST & WEST 2009

Developing Horse or Rider Division

Open to D-3s and up, minimum age 12 yrs., 2'9" – 3', 2 double combinations and no triple combinations.

This division is designed as an entry level division for the developing rider or horse. Competitor must qualify for this division at a Regional Rally per the Show Jumping Rule Book.

All Regional Policies regarding qualification for Championships will apply for this division.

In the jump off round the maximum height will not exceed 3'.

Note:

1. The committee recommends that this division be added to Championships for a 2 year trial period.
2. To qualify for Championships, all qualifying courses at Regional Rallies must reflect the technical aspects of a championship course.
3. The Show Jumping Committee strongly recommends that qualifiers have less than 12 jumping faults at their qualifying rally.

- **Reminder to All Qualifying Rally organizers** – Please remember to include on the Steward/TD Report the name(s) of the course designer(s) and to indicate that a minimum of 3 rounds were completed during the rally. You may have to add this information to the existing Steward Report. Make sure the Report is sent to the Activities Director at the National Office. The Show Jumping Committee uses these reports to determine the health of Show Jumping in all regions around the country.
